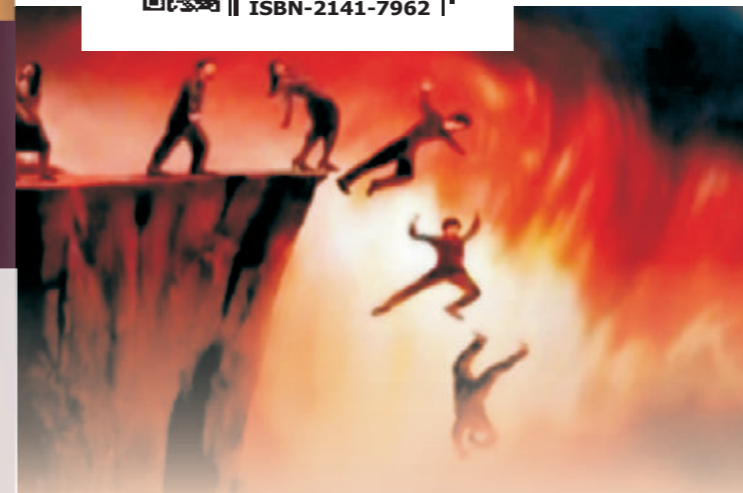

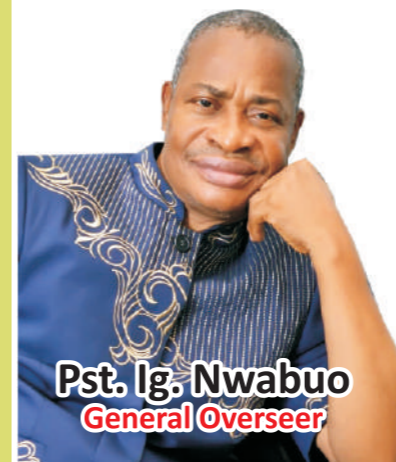

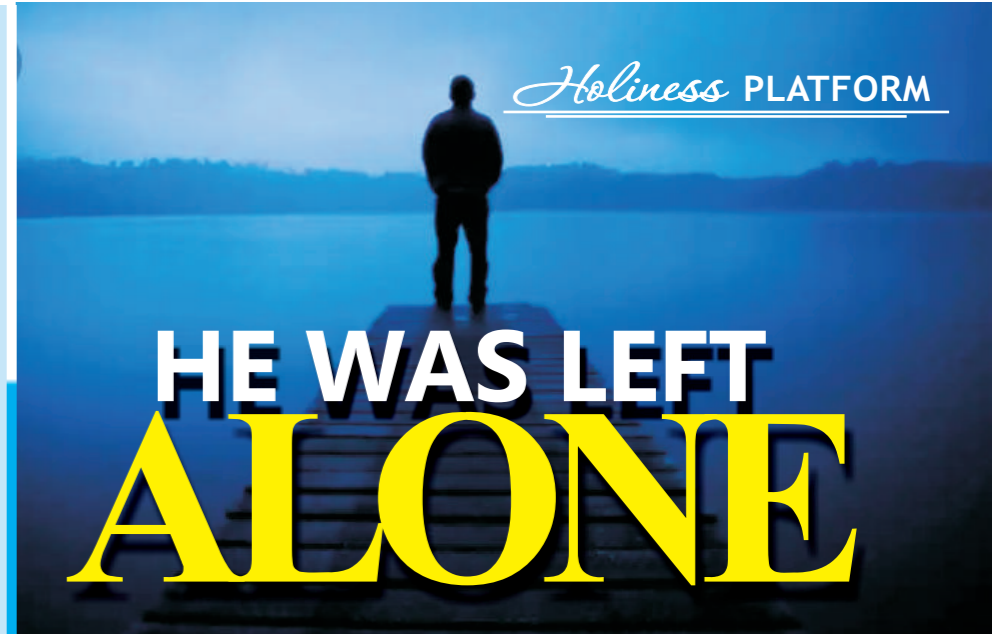

HE WAS LEFT ALONE

“And Jacob was left alone: and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day. And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh: and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him. And he said, let me go, for the day breaketh. And he said, I will not let thee go, except thou bless me. And he said unto him, what is thy name? And he said, Jacob. And he said, thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed. And Jacob asked him, and said, tell me, I pray thee, thy name. And he said, wherefore is it that thou dost ask after my name? And he blessed him there. And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: for I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved. And as he passed over Peniel the sun rose upon him, and he halted upon his thigh”. Gen.32:24-31.

Most times as a sister you are faced with problems that seems very difficult to solve. Yes most things are difficult to men but with God all things are possible. Luke 1:37. For Jacob meeting his elder brother Esau was a big challenge. Then Jacob sent messengers ahead to his brother Esau

in the land of Seir in Edom. He instructed them: “Tell my master Esau this, a message from your servant Jacob. I've been staying with Laban and couldn't get until now. I've acquired cattle and donkeys and sheep; also men and women servants. I'm telling you all this, my master, hoping for your approval”. The messengers came backs to Jacob and said, “We talked to your brother Esau and he's on his way to meet you. But he has four hundred men with him”. Gen. 32:4-6 (MB). This information brought fear upon Jacob. This made him map out strategies i.e what to do to appease his brother in all he was not comfortable. He resolve to call upon God (prayer) “And Jacob said, O God of my father Abraham, and God of my father Isaac; the Lord which sadist unto me, return unto thy country and to thy kindred, and I will deal well with thee”. Gen. 32:9. Jacob was afraid as he approached Esau's territory. Though it had been over twenty years, Jacob knew he had tricked his brother. He thought Esau would still be angry with him and react accordingly. So Jacob prayed to God for help. His prayer should be a pattern for all believers who find themselves in life threatening situations He reminded God of His

promise to protect those who follow His plans. He thanked God for all the undeserved blessings and help he had already received. He prayed for God to rescue him from the potentially harmful situation. He said the main reason he asked God to protect him was so he could fulfill God's purpose for his life. Prayer is very important, because it is the source of the power of believers. Jacob prayed He saw the need of being alone with God. He rose up in the night and took his two wives, his two maidservants, and his eleven children and crossed the ford of the Jabbok. He got them safely across the brook along with all his possessions. He was left alone and a man wrestled with him.

The man who wrestled with Jacob could be said to be the angel of the Lord. Who is often identified as God Himself. As Jacob desperately wrestled with God for the promised blessing and prevailed. But in the process, God attend the position of Jacob'sship as a reminder that Jacob should

no longer walk in his own strength but must rely entirely on God to direct his steps. This experience is a must for every true believer. We need God to put us in shape. This cannot be done in the public. We need to be alone with God for proper circumcision of our heart, the heart controls the body. God does not want us to depend on our understanding. He desired us to depend on Him.

The name, Jacob, 'a deceiver' had to be changed to Israel which means "he struggled and prevailed with God". Christ's followers are sometimes called the "Israel of God" "And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them and mercy, and upon the Israel of God. Gal. 6:16. This means "the God strugglers". God does not want His people to be passive, but to actively pursue God's blessings and grace. Jacob's overnight struggle with God resulted in God's blessing on his life. After that night, he knew that his life and success did not depend on his own methods and abilities but on God's help guidance and blessing. In process of time God reminded Israel's (the new Jacob) descendants of this truth: "Not by might nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the Lord of Hosts". Zech 4:6. Victory and blessing in the lives of all of God's people come the same way. While we may not wrestle physically with God, we can lay hold of him through intense and persistent prayers. Sometimes this involves confessing our sin and accepting His forgiveness. At other times it means expressing a deep and intense desire for his presence and the power of the Holy Spirit. It also involves a deliberate effort to trust God, discover His purposes and do what he considers right. God's dealing with Jacob did not only transform him, Esau also was transformed.

"And Jacob lifted up his eyes, looked and, behold, Esau came, and with him four hundred men. And he divided the children unto Leah and Rachel, and to the two handmaids. And he put the handmaids and their children foremost, and Leah and her children after and Rachel and Joseph hindermost. And he passed over before them, and bowed himself to the ground seven times, until he came near to his brother. And Esau ran to meet him, embraced him, and fell on his neck, and kissed him, and they wept". Gen. 33:1-4. Apparently, God had changed Esau over the years. He now wanted to make thing right with his brother. Esau's friendly attitude was God's answer to Jacob's prayer. He is the same God today and He can turn things around for our good if we hand our problems over to Him. As Jacob separated himself to Him, let us spend time with Him in the secret place. He that transformed Jacob to Israel and turned his brother that was coming to attack him with 400 soldiers to a friend, He will do the same for us, if we be with Him, "If a man's way please the Lord He will make his enemies to be at peace with him.

"And straightway Jesus constrained His disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while He sent the multitudes away. And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and the ship was now in the midst of the seas, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary. And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea." Matt. 14:22-25. As soon as the meal was

finished, He insisted that the disciples get in the boat and go on ahead to the other side while He dismissed the people. With the crowd dispersed, he climbed the mountain so He could be by Himself and pray. He stayed there alone, late into the night. While on earth Jesus often pulled away from the crowd and to spend time alone with His father. "And in the morning, rising up a great while before day, he went out, and departed unto a solitary place, and there prayed". Mark 1:35 if Jesus Himself needed this time, how much more should we show our dependence on God in this way. Time alone with God is essential to the spiritual well-being of every Christian. The lack of desire to pray is an unmistakable sign that one's spiritual life is in a process of decline. If this is happening, we must take a hard look at our lives and remove anything that offends God or gets in the way of our relationship with Him. We must then come boldly, but humbly, to Him and renew our commitment to spending time with him in prayer. Prayer is simply interacting with God, it's a two – way communication in which we speak but also learn to listen for God's responses and direction.

Sisters, with all the happenings in the world, let us go to God. We need His intervention. He is our defense, our hiding place. Nigeria is for Jesus. Nigeria and her fullness is of the Lord. Let us dwell in the secret place for safety. As you comply, **remain rapturable.**



In this context, an 'altar' is an established life of frequent access to God. An altar is not a monument or a structure, and it must not be restricted to a particular place; but then, if it is possible to have a particular place, it is then advisable. We want to look at what it means to have an Altarless life; what happens when a man's life is "not altared." As we look at the Scriptures, the first persons who did something which had to do with an altar happens to be Cain and his brother, Abel. And while Abel had a proper understanding, Cain had an understanding which wasn't deep; Cain's understanding was not proper, that though he had an altar, at the end of the day, while the sacrifice from Abel's altar got to Heaven, Cain's sacrifice didn't get to Heaven, and he got a rebuke, which led to him to becoming a vagabond.

Then in Genesis 6, the earth had plundered into error, several things had begun to happen, even to the point that the Sons of God upon seeing the daughters of men (and the iniquity of the earth), went into compromise... The earth had become so terrible... And many times I wondered, if the Sons of God who were in Heaven came to earth and compromised, what about the sons of men which were upon the earth before that time? This shows us the level of degradation the earth had gone through! The earth was in a mess; and continued so till Genesis 8. But in Genesis 6, we see that before the Lord made up His mind to destroy the earth and everything within, Noah found grace with God. At this point, it is easy to conclude that the reason for such grace was because the Lord loved Noah and his family; but it was as we progressed in the Scriptures that we discovered that Noah had a different life... There was something about Noah which we didn't know of at the beginning; because in Genesis 8:20 when he had come out of the Ark, the Bible relates that the first thing Noah did was to 'build (erect) an Altar', and perform sacrifice on it, and the aroma of this sacrifice got to Heaven. And when God smelled its sweet savour, on this basis, He made a decree saying, "...forever, I will not destroy the earth with flood..." And He gave the rainbow as a sign. So, the reason why, 'No matter how heavy the rain falls, we know the Lord won't

destroy the earth again with water is because a man erected an altar, and the Lord smelled the aroma of it, and came down.'

As we progress, in that same Book of Genesis, we find another man who took the business of altars a step further. Genesis 12:1-7. The Bible says the Lord had been speaking to Abraham about His intentions; and then at a point Abraham yielded and followed the Lord, and Lot went with him and his family members; and as they went, the Lord kept speaking to and reassuring him of His plans for his (Abram's) life. And we see that after the Lord had finished speaking with Abraham, Abraham built an altar to the Lord that appeared to him. Abraham's walk with God began on the basis of an altar. As we look at the Bible sayings we find the same thing; that for Paul, as we see in Galatians 1, he spoke of his being called and his decision not to confer with flesh and blood. What Paul meant is, "I did not become carnal... From the beginning of my faith, I went to Arabia..." And what this statement in turn means is-"I built an altar". This was what Abraham did. His walk with God started on the basis of altars; and he didn't just build an altar only when he began his walk with God, but continued building altars- Genesis 12:8. After this Scripture, through the Book of Genesis, you will discover that 'the altar' was a very sensitive part of Abraham's life. In Genesis 13, we saw that this man littered the land of the Canaanites with altars! Whenever he stumbled upon a new place, the first thing he did was to raise an altar to God. When we progress, we'll discover that every one who builded an altar

found something.... You should have read Romans 4:1- Paul said, "What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?" For Noah, as he kept on walking with God and building altars, he found Grace... But when Abraham began his own, even beyond faith he faithed... He had hope! So Abraham's walk with God, birthed Faith, so much so that he became the Father of Faith even when Jesus had not shed His blood. So everyone who built altars found something along the line. Altars get to God, and then makes several things available...

I want to let us know that 'there is no strong man without an altar.' The Bible says, "...no man ever goes to war on his own charge." Something must be sponsoring your life! There is no strong man, either in Light or in darkness, that is without the backing of an altar! If you are going to be strong or great, there must be a backing. It takes Nothing for Something to fall down. For instance, my pen can just fall down, it takes nothing. A STORY of ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE

Back in 1921, a missionary couple named David and Svea Flood went with their two-year-old son from Sweden to the heart of Africa—to what was then called the Belgian Congo. They met up with another young Scandinavian couple, the Ericksons, and the four of them sought God for direction. In those days of much tenderness and devotion and sacrifice, they felt led of the Lord to go out from the main mission station and take the gospel to a remote area. This was a huge step of faith. At the village of N'dolera they were rebuffed by the chief, who would not let them enter his town for fear of alienating the local gods. The two couples opted to go half a mile up the slope and build their own mud huts. They prayed for a spiritual breakthrough, but there was none. The only contact with the villagers was a young boy, who was allowed to sell them chickens and eggs twice a week. Svea Flood—a tiny woman of only four feet, eight inches tall—decided that if this was the only African she could talk to, she would try to lead the boy to Jesus. And in fact, she succeeded. But there were no other encouragements. Meanwhile, malaria continued to strike one member of the little band after another. In time the Ericksons decided they had had enough suffering and left to return to the central mission station. David and Svea Flood remained near N'dolera to go on alone. Then, of all things, Svea found herself pregnant in the middle of the primitive wilderness. When the time came for her to give birth, the village chief softened enough to allow a midwife to help her. A little girl was born, whom they named Aina. The delivery, however, was exhausting, and Svea Flood was already weak from bouts of malaria. The birth process was a heavy blow to her stamina. She lasted only another seventeen days. Inside David Flood, something snapped in that moment. He dug a crude grave, buried his twenty-seven-year-old wife, and then took his children back down the mountain

to the mission station. Giving his newborn daughter to the Ericksons, he snarled, "I'm going back to Sweden. I've lost my wife, and I obviously can't take care of this baby. God has ruined my life." With that, he headed for the port, rejecting not only his calling, but God himself. Within eight months both the Ericksons were stricken with a mysterious malady and died within days of each other.

The baby was then turned over to some American missionaries, who adjusted her Swedish name to "Aggie" and eventually brought her back to the United States at age three. This family loved the little girl and was afraid that if they tried to return to Africa, some legal obstacle might separate her from them. So they decided to stay in their home country and switch from missionary work to pastoral ministry. And that is how Aggie grew up in South Dakota. As a young woman, she attended North Central Bible college in Minneapolis. There she met and married a young man named Dewey Hurst. Years passed. The Hursts enjoyed a fruitful ministry. Aggie gave birth first to a daughter, then a son. In time her husband became president of a Christian college in the Seattle area, and Aggie was intrigued to find so much Scandinavian heritage there.

One day a Swedish religious magazine appeared in her mailbox. She had no idea who had sent it, and of course she couldn't read the words. But as she turned the pages, all of a sudden a photo stopped her cold. There in a primitive setting was a grave with a white cross—and on the cross were the words SVEA FLOOD. Aggie jumped into her car and went straight to a college faculty member who, she knew, could translate the article. "What does this say?" she demanded. The instructor summarized the story: It was about missionaries who

had come to N'dolera long ago...the birth of a white baby...the death of the young mother...the one little African boy who had been led to Christ...and how, after the whites had all left, the boy had grown up and finally persuaded the chief to let him build a school in the village. The article said that gradually he won all his students to Christ...the children led their parents to Christ...even the chief had become a Christian. Today there were six hundred Christian believers in that one village...All because of the sacrifice of David and Svea Flood. For the Hursts' twenty-fifth wedding anniversary, the college presented them with the gift of a vacation to Sweden. There Aggie sought to find her real father. An old man now, David Flood had remarried, fathered four more children, and generally dissipated his life with alcohol. He had recently suffered a stroke. Still bitter, he had one rule in his family: "Never mention the name of God—because God took everything from me." After an emotional reunion with her half brothers and sister, Aggie brought up the subject of seeing her father. The others hesitated. "You can talk to him," they replied, "though he's very ill now. But you need to know that whenever he hears the name of God, he flies into a rage."

Aggie was not to be deterred. She walked into the squalid apartment, with liquor bottles everywhere, and approached the seventy-three-year-old man lying in a rumpled bed. "Papa?" she said tentatively. He turned and began to cry.

"Aina," he said, "I never meant to give you away." "It's all right Papa," she replied, taking him gently in her arms. "God took care of me." The man instantly stiffened. The tears stopped. "God forgot all of us. Our lives have been like this because of Him." He turned his face back to the wall. Aggie stroked his face and then continued, undaunted. "Papa, I've got a little story to tell you, and it's true. You didn't go to Africa in vain. Mama didn't die in vain. The little boy you won to the Lord grew up to win that whole village to Jesus Christ. The one seed you planted just kept growing and growing. Today there are six hundred African people serving the Lord because you were faithful to the call of God in your life..."

"Papa, Jesus loves you. He has never hated you." The old man turned back to look into his daughter's eyes. His body relaxed. He began to talk. And by the end of the afternoon, he had come back to the God he had resented for so many decades.

Over the next few days, father and daughter enjoyed warm moments together. Aggie and her husband soon had to return to America—and within a few weeks, David Flood had gone into eternity. A few years

later, the Hursts were attending a high-level evangelism conference in London, England, where a report was given from the nation of Zaire (the former Belgian Congo). The superintendent of the national church, representing some 110,000 baptized believers, spoke eloquently of the gospel's spread in his nation. Aggie could not help asking him afterward if he ever heard of David and Svea Flood. "Yes, madam," the man replied in French, his words then being translated into English. "It was Svea Flood who led me to Jesus Christ. I was the boy who brought food to your parents before you were born. In fact, to this day your mother's grave and her memory are honored by all of us." He embraced her in a long, sobbing hug. Then he continued, "You must come to Africa to see, because your mother is the most famous person in our history." In time that was exactly what Aggie Hurst and her husband did. They were welcomed by cheering throngs of villagers. She even met the man who had been hired by her father many years before to carry her back down the mountain in a hammock-cradle. The most dramatic moment, of course, was when the pastor escorted Aggie to see her mother's white cross for herself. She knelt in the soil to pray and give thanks. Later that day, in the church, the pastor read from John 12:24: "I tell you the truth, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed.

But if it dies, it produces many seeds." He then followed with Psalm 126:5: "Those who sow in tears will reap with songs of joy." (An excerpt from Aggie Hurst, Aggie: The Inspiring Story of A Girl Without A Country [Springfield, MO: Gospel Publishing House, 1986].)
